- ❧ **KnockOut® series:** *original single, Pink, Double red, Double Pink, Sunny, White Out* — Larger size shrubs
- ❧ **Proven Winners Oso Easy® rose series:** *Cherry Pie, Honey Bun, Mango Salsa, Paprika, Peachy Cream, and Strawberry Crush* — small to medium size
- ❧ **Weeks** — *Red Home Run®, Pink HomeRun®* — medium size
- ❧ **David Austin English Roses*:** *Charlotte, Jude the Obscure, The Alnwick Rose, Lichfield Angel, Crosus Rose, L.D. Braithwaite, Lady of Megginch, Bishop's Castle, Lady In Shallot, Young Lycidas, Sophy's Rose, Wisley 2008* (all different sizes, go to David Austin website, but remember in the south all DA rose grow larger, disease tolerance is variable, trailed in Athens, Georgia.)
